The new build had to be the right fit for everyone. Initial ideas included tearing down her mom's cottage on the adjacent property and erecting a large compoundstyle building, something that could fit Kirsten, her

two children, her mom and her brother's family.

In the end, her mom's cottage remained and Kirsten enlisted Normerica to build

a 4,600-square foot, fourbedroom, five-bathroom custom timber frame cottage of her own.

"My dad had always envisioned using that property and building a big place there," recalls Kirsten. "So doing it was fulfilling doing something he wanted to do and never got a chance to. It's kind of nice that we have a place that we can all go to be close and be together."

The design includes future needs: a loft space is located above the garage so her two children, currently aged four and seven, can grow into the space as they become teenagers and young adults.

"Of the four bedrooms we have, the two kids' rooms can sleep four kids in each, so they can have friends over," says Kirsten. "I have a nice,
